



Study Visits by Groups of Foreign Students

- establish and maintain contacts between German and foreign universities
- provide participants with a subject-specific knowledge by organising visits to at least two universities, subject-related tours and informative meetings
- meetings with German students and academics and scientists and offer participants an insight into economic, political and cultural life in Germany
- University teachers from a foreign university are eligible to apply
- Study trips for groups of a maximum of 15 students accompanied by one university teacher. The groups visit at least two German universities where they participate in the academic programme. A cultural programme is to be organised in the evenings and at weekends.
- **Duration of funding:** At least 7 days and a maximum of 12 days
- **Application deadline:** 1 February, 1 May, 1 November

DAAD-MoST Summer Institute Programme

- Is a bilateral program between MoST and DAAD established in 2000
- The aim of the programme is
 - to interest graduates of the Taiwan Summer Institute Programme in Germany as a center of research and to encourage them to spend a longer period in the country.
 - to initiate personal relationships to collaborate with foreign counterparts in the future.
- Application deadline: end of February



短期博士或博士後研究獎學金 Research Grants for Doctoral Candidates and Young Academics (short-term)



- **Target Group: Doctoral candidates, Post-Docs**
- **Scholarship: Living expenses, health insurance, travel lump sum**
- **Objective: To carry out a research project at a German university or a non-university institution**
 - Length of the grant is set by the grant committee at the selection session; depending on the project grants can be paid generally for between one to six months
- **Application deadlines: twice a year**
 - April for funding from October
 - November for funding from April



博士生短期研究計畫

DAAD-MoST-Sandwich-Scholarship Programme

- **Target Group: Doctoral candidates from all disciplines who are already taking a doctoral degree in Taiwan**
- **The aim of the programme is to offer doctoral candidates from Taiwan the opportunity to become acquainted with the German research landscape. The doctoral degree is completed at the home university.**
 - **Duration of funding: 6-18 months**
 - **Scholarship:**
 - **2-month language course at the Goethe-Institut Bonn**
 - **Monthly scholarship payments**
 - **Travel allowance**
- **Selection is made by the Ministry of Science and Technology (MoST) in Taiwan and DAAD in Bonn**

博士、博士後研究獎學金

Scholarships for PhD/Postdocs

- **Target Group:** Doctoral students and young academics/scientists from all disciplines with a diploma or master degree and post-docs
- **Scholarship:** Living expenses, health insurance, travel lump sum plus subsidiary allowances
- **Objective:** To carry out a research project within the scope of a doctorate; extension studies
 - **Doctoral Programmes in Germany:** (up to 4 years)
 - **Cotutelle Doctoral Programmes** (up to 18 months)
 - **One-Year Grants:** Research projects or continuing education without aiming for a formal degree (up to 10 months)
- **Application deadline:** 15th of November



研究獎學金

Bilateral Exchange of Academics

- **Target Group: Postdocs and scientists**
- **Scholarship: Living expenses, travel lump sum**
- **Objective: Research stays at state or state-recognised institutions of higher education or non-university research institutes in Germany**
 - **Duration: At least 14 days up to a maximum of three months**
- **Application deadline: The applications can be handed in at any time, but at least three months before the required beginning of the stay**



雙邊合作計畫人員交流計畫

Project Related Personal Exchange (Mobility Funding)

- bilateral program with 31 partner institutions worldwide to initiate new or intensify existing scientific cooperation between HEI and research institutes
- Funding is supposed to finance mobility within a joint research project of high quality
- Focus on supporting early career researchers
- Complementarity and reciprocity of the research of the participating partners are necessary
- Funding intended as initial funding for further international funding schemes, duration in general limited to 2 years
- Application Deadline: 30th of June



MoST-DFG 雙邊協議國際合作研究計畫



MoST-DFG Taiwan-German Collaboration in Research



- This initiative aims to bring together relevant and competitive researchers from Germany and Taiwan to design and carry out collaborative research projects.

Funds to be used by the Taiwanese side must be requested from MoST; funds to be used by the German side must be requested from DFG.

- Research funding for a period of up to three years.



- Proposals must be submitted to both organisations in accordance with the proposal preparation requirements of both sides, respectively.

- Next application: February 18th
