IIPP (NSTC International Internship Pilot Program)

This program provides foreign students with the opportunity to engage in R&D activities at top local research institutions, along with living subsidies. Interns can gain access to our cutting-edge labs on Taiwan's Island of Silicon



SUBSIDIES ITEMS

- ▶▶ NSTC provides each participant with a **monthly subsidy of NT\$30,000 (about EUR 922)** for up to 3 months during the internship period.



DURATION

- ▶▶ The internship can last **up to 3 months**, with students able to arrange their schedule based on their academic requirements.

ELIGIBILITY

- ▶▶ **Undergraduate** and **graduate** students of foreign nationality, who meet the criteria for specific fields listed on the official website.

TEEP (Taiwan Experience Education Program)

Since 2015, Taiwan's Ministry of Education launched the Taiwan Experience Education Program (TEEP) to encourage international students to participate in short-term professional internship organized by Taiwanese universities and colleges.



SUBSIDIES ITEMS

- ▶▶ Taiwan's ministry of education provides each participant with a **monthly subsidy of NT\$12,000 (about EUR 369)** for up to 6 months during the internship period.



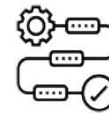
