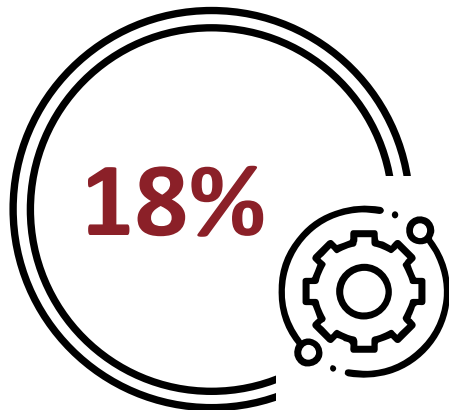
No. of Startups Founded

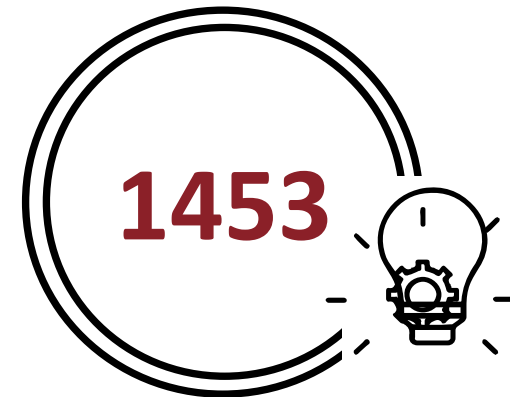

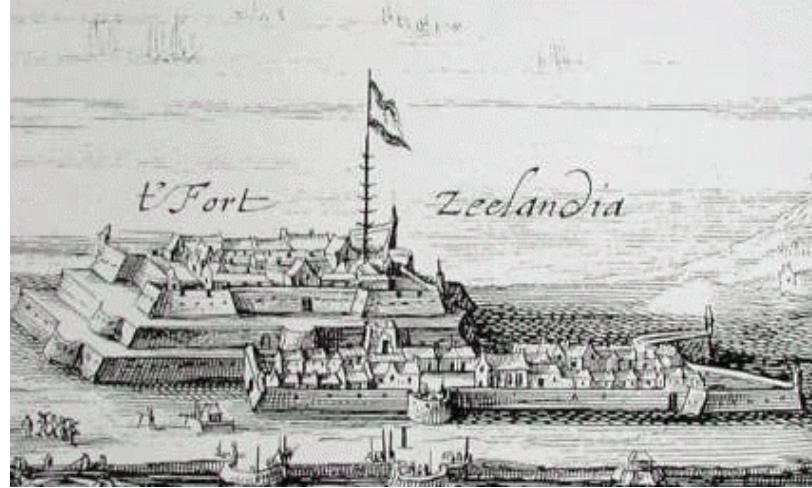

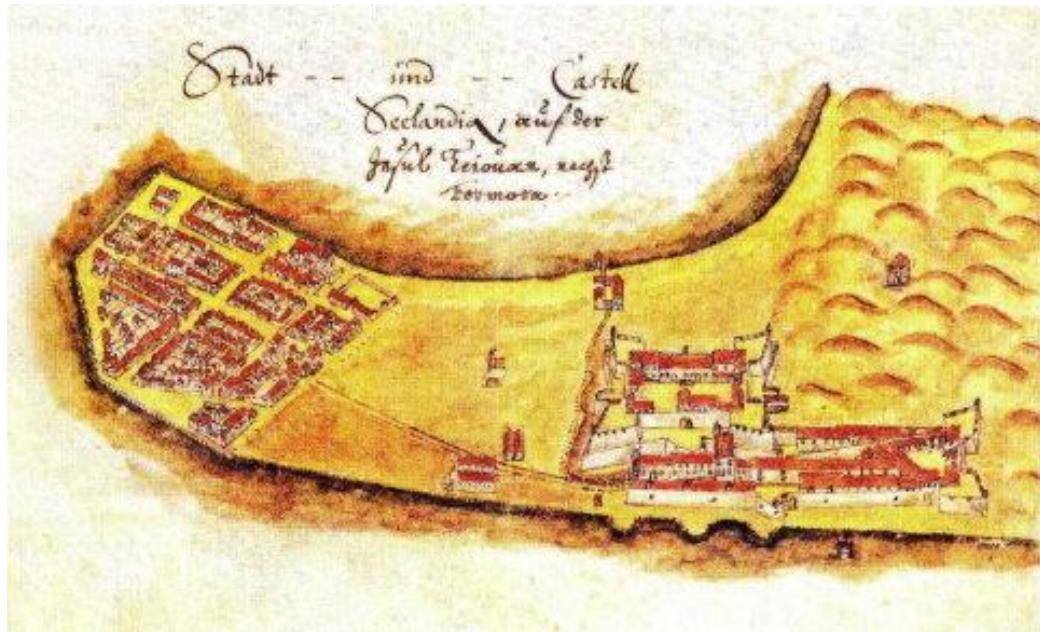

Archaeology (found the historic remains of the *Fort Zeelandia*)

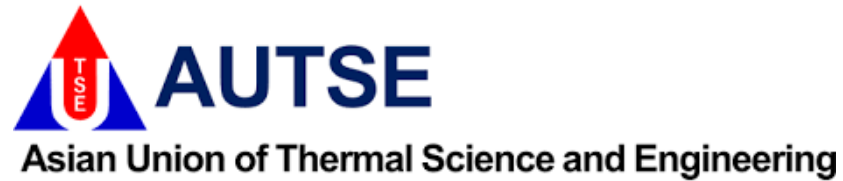


The Fort Zeelandia was the earliest colony in Taiwanese history built by Dutch East India Company (1624-1634) at the Age of Discovery.
