EVENT DETAILS

Thursday, July 14 (9:00 am - 10:00 am)

Meeting Session. Meet with the ATAYAL Organization to understand history and culture of the greater Indigenous Taiwanese populations in Taiwan. Understand why Taiwan is an island that celebrates cultural diversity and what this diversity means for the future of the island.

Thursday, July 21 (9:00 am - 10:00 am)

Students will meet in small groups (2-3 USA students, 2-3 Taiwanese students in a virtual meeting room).

The class will be divided into 2 x 30-minute segments, one in which the US students lead the topic in Chinese, the other in which the Indigenous Taiwanese students lead in English.

Students will try to help each other with their language as they go through and will respond and discuss throughout the entire session.

The students will know a theme for discussion beforehand (i.e. SPORTS and HOBBIES) and they will present their own ideas on this for their half hour segment, and chat about the topic with the other students.

We will provide a moderator for the discussion but it will be mostly be student-led and the students will be encouraged to respond to each other.

Thursday, July 28 (9:00 am - 10:00 am)

This session will be the same as the previous one, with the Themed topic of Popular CULTURAL CELEBRATIONS AND FESTIVALS.
