DBMD Application Deadlines

- Fall: April 1
- Spring: October 15*
 - * Not all majors open for Spring admission. Please check with Global Programs to confirm.

DBMD Application Process

- Step 1: DBMD applicants first complete the online Global Programs form. https://apply.temple.edu/Global
- **Step 2:** DBMD applicants then visit the related School/College online application portal (listed below) to complete their master's application.

Qualifications

Entrance requirements vary by master's program and can be found at www.temple.edu/gradbulletin. Students have the best chance of being admitted if they meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Apply in 3rd or 4th year, or after graduation.
- Minimum TOEFL® iBT 79; IELTS 6.5; Duolingo 110 (majors in disciplines such as Business or Communications require higher scores).
- GPA of 3.5/4.5 (3.0/4.0 or approximately 80%).
- GRE waived for most programs, except Fox School of Business (but waivers considered).
- Completed undergraduate coursework meets most of the academic prerequisites of the graduate program.

Note: Students must maintain a 3.0 GPA while enrolled at Temple.

<u>Application Materials – Please Submit Online</u>

- **DBMD Study Plan:** Select appropriate Temple graduate courses to fulfill remaining undergraduate requirements. If all undergraduate requirements will be completed prior to beginning at Temple, a DBMD Study Plan is not required.
- Letters of Recommendation: 1-3 letters of recommendation (depending on master's).
- Resume or Curriculum Vitae
- **TOEFL, IELTS, or Duolingo Score:** Applicants who have not received a degree in the United States are required to take an approved language exam.
- Standardized Test Scores: The GRE and GMAT are waived for majors outside of the Fox School of Business. Applicants to Fox may be eligible for a waiver on a case-by-case basis. For Fox applicants not receiving a waiver, GMAT or GRE scores can be forwarded electronically to Temple University's Graduate School (Institution Code: 2906).
- Transcripts: Official transcripts from all previous universities attended.
- Application for Certificate of Eligibility (Form I-20): Submitted via separate application: https://isss.temple.edu/students/future-students/certificate-eligibility-application-process
