

## **Chiba Institute of Technology**

### **The Academic Fellowship Program for Cooperative Universities 2025-26**

Chiba Institute of Technology (CIT) conducts an academic fellowship program, which provides overseas faculty academic members of CIT's cooperative universities with an opportunity to conduct collaborative research, discussions, and opinion exchanges with researchers. The applicant must, in principle, be a faculty academic member who is employed full-time at a university that has signed the academic agreement with CIT. CIT is looking forward to applications from people taking up this opportunity.

#### **The number of people recruited**

6(The accepted number may be subject to change at the discretion of CIT)

#### **Terms and conditions**

The period of the stay for the program must be a minimum of fourteen days and a maximum of three months from the middle of January 2026 through the 13th of March 2026. Participants of the program must pursue educational or academic activities in collaboration with CIT faculty.

Participants of the program will be granted the following from CIT:

#### **International Airfare**

The cost of economy class roundtrip airfare between the nearest international airport of the participant's home country and Tokyo (please note that the maximum amount allowed is 200,000 JPY from both European countries and North / Central American countries, and 100,000 JPY from Asian countries).

Research expenses: Maximum 100,000 JPY

#### **Accommodation and meals**

CIT has a few guest rooms available at the university's student dormitory. As long as there are vacant rooms, the guest rooms are available free of charge to the participants of this program. To take advantage of this opportunity, you can make a provisional guest room booking once your invitation has been accepted.

Meals, living expenses (hotel or accommodations except for the CIT's guest room), private transportation and other miscellaneous expenses during your stay are the

responsibility of the participant. We really would like you to enjoy your stay with us; so, as a participant of this program, you will have access to an impressive range of campus facilities, including a cafeteria and gym. We have some cafeterias where all participants can eat on campus and the facility typically offers a choice of individually priced hot and cold meals, noodles (ramen, soba, udon and pasta), a salad, desserts, sandwiches, snacks and hot and cold drinks etc. at very reasonable prices.

If the applicant has difficulty finding a collaborator, CIT may recommend one whose academic field is similar to the applicants or an invitation may not be available.
